



Construction Update - L.I.F.E. Services Centre

As posted in our Notice on May 4, 2020, the Province of Ontario announced that some essential construction projects could reopen, as long as they meet “strict public health measures and operate safely during the COVID-19 outbreak”.

HFN Council has reviewed JR Certus’s extensive “Return to Work” policy and based on those guidelines has approved them to recommence the construction at the L.I.F.E. Services Centre effective Monday May 11, 2020, with the following safety precautions put in place:

- JR Certus will implement a screening process to be initiated before any site workers/management team member enter the work site;
- There will be a daily log book that all workers/management team members will sign to confirm that they have screened negative for symptoms of COVID -19
- The site workers/management team member will have a specific pass to allow them past the checkpoint without any contact with the volunteers;
- The site workers/management team member will not be utilizing the Old Railroad Stop;
- The site workers management team member / will practice social distancing and will use proper sanitizing procedures as recommended.
