We are pleased to announce that Hiawatha First Nation will be hosting its COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics for those 12 -17 years of age at the “Gathering Place” in the new building at 431 Hiawatha Line on **Saturday, June 12, 2021!**

These clinics are open to:

- All HFN Citizens 12 – 17 years of age (On and Off Territory)
- All Youth 12 - 17 years of Age Residing In a Citizens Household (On and Off Territory)
- All Youth 12 - 17 years of age who Resides with an HFN Employee full-time
- All Youth 12 – 17 years of age Residing Full Time within Hiawatha boundaries. (ie Kent’s Bay Road, HFN Lessees) ~ Proof of residency may be required

If you are interested in having your child(ren) 12 – 17 years of age vaccinated please call **705-295-4421** no later than **Monday, May 31, 2021**. Please be patient when calling as we anticipate a high volume of calls. Remember, you have ample time to sign up your child(ren).

When you call, please leave your name and the name(s) of your child(ren), along with your contact information. A member of the HFN Health Team will contact you directly, to obtain all necessary further information no later June 7, 2021.

Your child(ren) will be receiving the Pfizer vaccine and it is **IMPERATIVE** you speak to your child(ren) health care professional if you have any questions or concerns about whether the vaccine is right for them.
