WARNING: Drug Poisoning Alert in Belleville

Peterborough Public Health is sharing information about an event that occurred in a neighboring region. Details on this event are below:

Date: Tuesday, February 6, 2024

Context: 13-15 opioid related poisonings occurred in a 1-2 hour period.

Assumed Substance: Blueish-Orange.

Please note – this is anecdotal information shared by Hasting Prince Edward Public Health. **Reports of these events linked to this substance have NOT been verified.**

ACTIONS:

- **Drug Checking**
 - o Drug checking is available at the CTS (220 Simcoe St.) today and tomorrow 9 a.m. – 9 p.m.
 - o Outside of those hours, test strips are available for fentanyl, benzos, and xylazine.
- **Harm Reduction Support:**
 - o Consumption & Treatment Site – 220 Simcoe St. Open 9:30 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.; daily
 - o National Overdose Response Service – 1-888-688-6677(NORS)
 - o Krasman Centre - Warm Line & Peer Crisis Support Services – 1-888-777-0979
